"BATTLE OF THE BOOKS"

America's Battle of the Books is a reading incentive program for students in grades 3-6. The purpose is to encourage students to read good books and have fun, while competing with peers.

Students will be part of a team of 4 to 5 students. Each team will read as many books as possible from the book list for their grade. There are 20 books on each grade level list (see school website for list). Students do not have to read every book on the list; however, the more books each person on the team reads the better chance they have when answering questions about the books in a battle. Teams will be formed by the teachers so that each team consists of a blend of reading levels, to ensure the success of every team. In March, teams will come together for a competition tournament where they will work as a team to answer questions about the books from the list.

We will have 10 copies of each book title available for checkout in the school library. You may also find the titles at the local library.

Be sure to mark your calendar for **March 16th-20th** for Bastian's Battle of the Books March Madness! 3rd and 4th grades will battle Monday and Tuesday morning. 5th and 6th grades will battle Wednesday and Thursday morning.
