II. Safe Walking Routes - Pick-up/Drop-off

The council voiced concerns about walking routes. Jonathon shared the following information with Blake (City) and we will hear back as they decide

Red: The building construction along Big Bend is posing significant hazards. The Chairman provided various of pictures as examples (also attached to the exhibit). They all emphatically agree that this stretch is unsafe.

Pink: This stretch was proposed by the Principal and the Chairman. It would take them off Big Bend and onto the Bastian field. I pointed out that it appears to be private property and will become part of a lot in the future phases of development.

Purple: Many kids utilize the HAWK signal to avoid the longer route and crossing Miller Crossing. They want to know the feasibility of using the HAWK signal and removing the portion of the route that would lead the across Miller Crossing.

Blue: The asphalt path through Herriman detention property came up as a solution to avoid the construction on Big Bend. It also appears to be used by all pedestrians that have to walk through the intersection of Anthem & Herriman Blvd. I brought up the concerns associated with this path including the need for a Mid-Block crossing to avoid the dangerous crossing at the Bid Bend corner, which may necessitate a crossing guard. I also pointed out that UPD/HPD have concerns with allowing routes along trails/pathways along private property.

Additional Points for Follow-Up: Since the routes to avoid Big Bend appear to be encumbered with concerns, we briefly discussed how to mitigate the construction hazards along Big Bend if that's the route that sticks. Those items include 1) posting "No-Parking" or Staging on one side of the road to keep the other side clear, 2) using the UFA clearance requirement card, 3) additional code or PD enforcement in this area to the sidewalks clear. Perhaps we can fine contractors that don't leave the walk route safely open.

III. Code of Conduct We previewed the Bastian Code of Conduct and asked for feedback before it gets sent out to all parents/students.

IV. Boundary Review The council reviewed the process for the upcoming boundary change. Website was given and the letter sent out from the District was also given to members
